Junior Players Code of Conduct

- 1. Abide by the rules of the game set down by your coach, club and league.
- 2. Never argue with and official or umpire. If you disagree, have your captain, coach, or team manager approach the officials during a break or after the competition.
- Control your temper. Verbal or physical abuse of officials, umpires, spectators, or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted.
- 4. Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit, so will you.
- 5. Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are your team, opponent or other team. Be proud to walk off the ground after each game knowing that you have given your best effort and never involve yourself in an argument with opposing players, umpires or officials.
- 6. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player. Your involvement to play is for fun and enjoyment and that winning is only a part of it.
- 7. Co-operate with you coach and teammates. And respect the ability of your opponent. Without them there would be no game.
- 8. Play for 'the fun of it' and not just to please parents and coaches.
- 9. Avoid use of de3rogatory language based on gender or race.
